



Clayton Youth Enrichment Rules and Expectations

Discipline is an educational process by which Clayton Youth Enrichment staff assist children and youth to develop the experience and self-control necessary to gradually assume responsibility for their own behavior. Discipline practices are non-punitive, developmentally appropriate, and based on the unique needs of each child/youth. Clayton Rules and expectations are as follows:

1. Respect everyone, including other children, youth, staff, visitors, parents, etc.
2. Resolve disagreements in a positive manner, independently or with the help of staff.
3. Keep your hands and feet to yourself. This includes kicking, hitting, biting, poking, etc.
4. Use appropriate language. No Cursing, or name calling.
5. Do not leave the program area without permission. Staff must know where you are at all times.
6. No running inside.
7. Leave all toys and personal electronics at home. This includes cellphones. Clayton YES! will not be responsible for lost or stolen items.
8. Treat all equipment/property with respect. Examples: athletic equipment, art supplies, furniture, etc.
9. No Bullying.
10. Be ready to learn new and exciting things! You will participate in daily enrichment activities.
11. Have Fun. Enjoy yourself!
